Microtransit

Technology-enabled multi-passenger services that use computer generated routes, with vehicles ranging from sports utility vehicles to shuttle buses. Examples are Via and Chariot.



Bike-share

Services that provide members with access to a bike for intervals less than one day. Examples are Capital Bikeshare (DC) and Divvy (Chicago).



Ridesourcing

Technology-enabled services that connect passengers with drivers and automate customer reservations, payments, and feedback. Examples are Uber and Lyft.



Car-share

Services that provide members with access to a vehicle for intervals less than one day. Examples are Car2Go and ReachNow.
