SUBJECT: Regional Grants – Safe Streets 4 All and Adaptation Planning

### **Informational Report**

At past meetings the TAC has requested that HCAOG review grant opportunities from the Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act (IIJA or BIL) and other sources and report back on opportunities that may be appropriate for a regional focus. Associate Planner Stephen Luther will share a presentation with more detailed information and possible regional applications for the following grant opportunities.

#### Safe Streets and Roads 4 All (SS4A)

SS4A is a federal grant program intended to reduce and eliminate roadway fatalities and serious injuries. The Notice of Funding Opportunity is live and the application deadline is July 10<sup>th</sup>. The program's 40% set-aside requirement for planning grants was undersubscribed last year, so there is even more available in this round.

#### Climate Adaptation Grants

There are two climate adaptation grant programs HCAOG is tracking for a potential regional project. The Caltrans Sustainable Transportation Climate Adaptation Planning Grant (CAPG) program will be opening for a second cycle, as there is approximately \$30 million remaining. Caltrans anticipates hosting workshops for the second round in June, with the second cycle being released in the fall.

The California Transportation Commission Local Transportation Climate Adaptation Program (LTCAP) seeks to provide competitive grants to local agencies for the development and implementation of capital projects adapting local transportation infrastructure to climate changes. The call for projects will be released on May 17 and project nominations are due July 19.
