Staff’s Recommended Action:

“The PAC recommends that the HCAOG Board adopt Resolution 23-03 and Resolution 23-04 approving the City of Ferndale’s FY 22-23 and FY 23-24 LTF claims.”

Staff Summary:

The Transportation Development Act (TDA) provides two major sources of funding, Local Transportation Funds (LTF) and State Transit Assistance (STA) funds, for public transportation in California administered by Regional Transportation Planning Agencies. Each jurisdiction has its own LTF account held at the County Auditor’s office. HCAOG’s role is to ensure that claim forms submitted conform to TDA regulations.

The LTF revenues are derived from a 1/4 cent of the general sales tax collected statewide. In February 2022, the HCAOG Board adopted Resolution 22-06 approving the TDA LTF findings of apportionment and allocation for FY 2022-23. Similarly, in February 2023 the Board adopted Resolution 23-01 approving FY 2023-24 allocations.

The City of Ferndale’s LTF claims for FY 2022-23 in the amount of \$57,512 and FY 2023-24 in the amount of \$72,888 has been reviewed in accordance with the TDA Guidelines and HCAOG’s TDA Rules and Regulations and is recommended for approval.
